Tennis Etiquette – If you or your family are unfamiliar with the behaviour you need to display at **Australian Competitive Play Events**, please be aware of the [tennis etiquette rules](#) and within the [Code of Behaviour: Competitive Play](#) national policy.

Matches played without a chair umpire – The majority of tennis matches at **Australian Competitive Play Events** will be played without a chair umpire. Please be aware of the specific procedures for [Matches played without a chair umpire](#).

Withdrawal deadline and Late Withdrawal Rule – A player is permitted four (4) Late Withdrawal and/or Failure to Complete Match or Tournament violations in a calendar year without incurring disciplinary points. Please read the additional information regarding this new policy within the [Code of Behaviour: Competitive Play](#)

Entering two tournaments at the same time – An athlete may enter and play a draw (including qualifying draws) in different events where any of the dates of those events overlap, however they must complete all commitments to the earlier event by the day before their first match of the second event that has been scheduled. Under no circumstances can an athlete be an active participant in two overlapping events on the same day. Refer to the “Entering two events” rule within the **Australian Competitive Play Regulations** document.
