Entering two tournaments at the same time – An athlete may enter and play a draw (including qualifying draws) in different events where any of the dates of those events overlap, however they must complete all commitments to the earlier event by the day before their first match of the second event that has been scheduled. Under no circumstances can an athlete be an active participant in two overlapping events on the same day. All entrants (including players from overseas) must be registered with Tennis Queensland or any other Tennis Australia Member (State) association. Registration with Tennis Queensland is free through TQ affiliated bodies. All players must provide their 11-digit Tennis Australia My Tennis Player ID Number to enter on-line.

N.B. When players go to enter on-line, they are asked to create a Tournament account if they don't already have one. To create a Tournament account, players need their 11-digit Tennis Australia My Tennis Player ID Number. Players who do not have a Player ID Number, or don't remember their number, need to contact Tennis Australia via play@tennis.com.au or 1800 752 983 to obtain their number or have a number created for them.

Check the scheduled times for the initial round-robins and do not enter two Round-Robin events scheduled for the same initial session time. Players are required for the entire AM or PM session, during which time they will play all other players/pairs in their group.

Session times are AM (morning session, 8 a.m. to approx. 12:30 p.m.) and PM (afternoon session, 12:30 p.m. to approx. 5 p.m.).

COURT SURFACES:

Open, 18 & Under and Special events will be played on hardcourts (Rebound Ace Synpave). Seniors events may be played on synthetic grass courts & hardcourts as there are only 2 synthetic grass courts at UQ. Other events may be played on hardcourts or synthetic grass courts.

OPEN & JUNIOR EVENT FORMATS:

All Open and Junior events will be Rating and Gender based. There will be a Qualifying event (up to 32 players) for the Open Singles if entries exceed 32, and additional Tiers based on ratings bands if entries exceed 56 (e.g. Tier 2, Tier 3, etc.). All players 18 & Under are eligible for the Junior events. Entrants in Junior events will be split into multiple draws based on ratings bands (e.g. Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3, etc.). All Open and Junior events will be knock-out (single elimination) draws.

MATCH PLAY (CONSOLATION) EVENTS:

There will be on-site sign-on optional Match Play (consolation) events for early round losers in all Tiers of the Open and Junior Singles events. For a 16-player draw, the first round losers only will be eligible for the Match Play event. For 16+ player draws, the first and second round losers will be eligible for the Match Play event. Eligible players for a Match Play event have



until 5 minutes after the conclusion of the last match in the relevant round of the main or qualifying draw to sign on at the Tournament Office for the Match Play event. Only those who sign on for the Match Play event will be drawn to play. Each Match Play event will be a new knock-out draw.

There are no Doubles Match Play (Consolation) events.

SPECIFIC TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE: The Tournament Committee shall have the entire control and management of the tournament, subject to the provisions of Tennis Australia's 2022 Australian Competitive Play Open & Junior Regulations. Any matter not specifically covered in the applicable tournament rules and regulations shall be resolved by the Committee members present, whose decision shall be final.

AGE EVENT ELIGIBILITY: Entrants in Age events must supply their birth dates and produce their birth certificates if requested. Eligibility for Junior events is based on the player being 18 & Under as at 31 July 2022 (i.e. born 1 August 2003 or later). Senior events are open to players who reach the relevant age at any time during the year of the tournament or earlier (i.e. 35 & Over – born 19877 or earlier; 40 & Over – born 1982 or earlier; 45 & Over – born 1977 or earlier; 50 & Over – born 1972 or earlier; 55 & Over – born 1967 or earlier; 60 & Over – born 1962 or earlier).

GRADE EVENT ELIGIBILITY: Round-Robin Grade event eligibility shall be determined by players' UTRs. Where players are Un-Rated or have a Not Reliable Rating (i.e. have insufficient results for a Reliable Rating), eligibility will be determined from other information, such as Fixture grades. The listed Fixture grade cut-offs for Round-Robin Grade events are approximate only. Fixture players are required to disclose all relevant information about their current Fixtures (organising bodies, competitions, seasons, team names & grades) and their ITN and/or UTR (if known). This information should be supplied as Remarks under "Remarks". Grade event entries without this information may not be accepted. Where partners in Grade Doubles events are of different standards, event eligibility shall be decided on the basis of the higher standard. The Committee reserves the right to transfer a player to a higher level event if it deems the player to be above the designated standard for the level entered and is not required to give a reason or to advise the player beforehand. If a player is found to have been allowed to play in too low a Grade



event because of undisclosed or false information about Fixture grades, that player may be defaulted. For more information about the Universal Tennis Rating (UTR) go to https://www.universaltennis.com.

WITHDRAWALS: Players who withdraw from an event after 11:59 p.m. on Wednesday, 6 July, or withdraw from an event during the tournament, may be penalised under the TA Code of Behaviour. Withdrawal notification must be in writing (by e-mail or post but not by SMS or social media).

REFUNDS: Where any full or partial entry fee refunds are due, the refund will be calculated excluding the Stripe & Tennis Australia processing fee.

ENTRIES: Entries must be lodged with all fees by 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, 3 July.

Entries for the Open Singles & Doubles events and Junior Singles events may only be lodged on-line with credit card payment. Entries for all other events may be lodged on-line with credit card payment or by using the printed entry form which can be downloaded from https://www.uqtc.org.au.

Entries lodged without payment will not be included in the draws.

Players may enter in more than three events but, in such cases, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to reject entries where the number of events entered could make it difficult to schedule all the matches required. Players may not enter more than one Round-Robin event scheduled for the same initial session time.

Players should check on-line (at https://tournaments.tennis.com.au) that their entries have been received and to verify the events in which they are entered.

TIME EXEMPTIONS: Players must be available at all times during the tournament. Any time exemption requests will be ignored. The Tournament Time Draw cannot be organised around players' other activities.



MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENT: For an event to be conducted, a minimum of four entries will generally be required. Where there are less than four entries, the event may be cancelled and entrants given the option of transferring to another event or receiving a refund.

MATCHES: Events 1-2 shall be played using the Knock-Out format and all matches shall be the best-of-three tie-break sets. Events 3-5, 6-7 & 8-12 and all Match Play events shall be played using the Knock-Out format and all matches shall be two tie-break sets but, if the score reaches one set all, the match will be decided by a match tie-break (10 points)]. In any set, if the score reaches six games all, a tie-break game shall be played to determine the winner of the set.

Events 13 to 44 shall be played using Round-Robin formats. Depending on numbers, players in each event will be split into groups with group winners going on to compete in play-offs to determine the event winner. Match lengths will be determined by the Committee prior to play starting but would normally be one first-to-six-games set with a tie-break at five-all or a first-to-nine-games set with a tie-break at eight-all.

In all events, matches may be scheduled to be played or completed under lights.

Dependent on entry numbers, some event formats may differ from those advertised.

DOUBLES: All Doubles pairs nominations must be entered by 6 July. Where a player enters a Doubles event without nominating a partner or where the nominated partner does not enter that event, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to pair such players as per the procedures outlined in the Australian Ranking Tournament Rules and Regulations or to take additional sign-on entries but only to complete a pair.

DRAW AVAILABILITY: It is each player's responsibility to ascertain the time draw and to be in attendance at the courts at the time(s) set down. The Tournament Committee will endeavour to notifying players about their definite match times and possible follow-on match times in each event by e-mail but players can check on-line for their match times (at https://tournaments.tennis.com.au).



CHECK-IN & NO-SHOWS: Each player should report to the Tournament Office and have his/her name checked off as being present at least 15 minutes before the scheduled time of each match (or session start time for round-robin events). Any player not ready to play or refusing to play within 15 minutes of his/her match being called may be defaulted. A player defaulted as a "No-Show" may be permitted to play in other events, including consolations, at the discretion of the Referee provided the player contacts the Tournament Office within one hour of the time scheduled for the match. All other players defaulted as a "No Show" will be taken out of all other events in the tournament, including Match Play events.

SCORECARDS: A completed scorecard must be returned to the Tournament Office for a match result to be credited. All players in a match are responsible for checking their own results are correct on the scorecard before it is lodged as, once lodged, the result is unlikely to be changed if later disputed.

ON-LINE RESULTS: It is a condition of entry that players agree to allow the Tournament Committee to publish results (including names and scores) on the Tennis Australia Tournaments Website (https://tournaments.tennis.com.au) and provide results to Universal Tennis for ratings calculations.

PRIZEMONEY & REFUNDS: Payment of prizemoney and refunds will be by internet bank transfer. Players winning prizemoney or eligible for a refund must provide full bank account details to receive payment (i.e. name of bank, BSB, account number and account name).

JUNIOR PLAYERS: Tournament Officials are not able to supervise children (i.e. persons under 18 years of age) playing in this Tournament. Entries from juniors are only accepted on the understanding that the supervision and protection of children during their participation in the University Open Tennis Championships is the responsibility of their parents/guardians and not the Tournament Committee and other Tournament Officials.

PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT: By indicating acceptance of the entry conditions when entering on-line, participants or parents/guardians of junior entrants, acknowledge and confirm that they have read and understood and agree to be bound by the above terms and the Tennis Australia Standard Tournament Entry Conditions listed under Regulations.
