

Queensland Regional Shield of the Year

The Queensland Regional Shield of the Year is given to the region who as a unified body undertakes projects to involve the wider community in tennis. As a collective they come up with and promote initiatives aimed at bringing more people to the sport across the region to give benefit to all clubs. The Region actively involves its players from junior's right up to seniors in programs across the region.

Every region is eligible

In one page only the region must demonstrate that it meets the following criteria:

- Engages their participation leader in the region to work on the regions measurable outcomes
- Advocates and engages clubs to implement Tennis Australia programs and competitions
- As a unified region, undertake projects which involve the wider tennis community with Tennis Australia
- Collectively create and promote initiatives aimed at bringing people to the sport
- Utilise allocated RIP funding to grow the sport in their region

Selection criteria

Description

Region must list and submit any initiatives/programs they have established as a collective to grow tennis

Engages the Tennis and wider LGA community at related meetings, events and activations

The percentage of the overall affiliates in the region and their Club Health Check total

Support's the junior members of the region through regional team entry in annual JDS Finals and Junior Team's Carnival events

Encourages inclusivity across all areas of the sport. I.e. players, spaces, coaches, administration, officials

All entries must supply a minimum of three high-resolution photos and/or video footage supporting their nomination.

Selection process

- Nominees should attach any relevant additional information with their nomination form
- All entries must supply a minimum of three (3) high-resolution photos and/or video footage supporting their nomination. Please be aware of size limitations if submitting via email – if required please use alternative data-sharing methods to submit such as Dropbox or USB.
- Only information provided with the nomination form will be considered by the selection panel
- You must consult with a Tennis Queensland staff member and have them sign off on your application before final submission

All decisions in relation to the award (including any questions in relation to eligibility) will be determined by a selection panel in its absolute discretion. All decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Timeline

- Nominations close – Midnight Monday 10 September 2018
- Finalists announced – Week commencing Friday 28 September 2018
- The Tennis Queensland Awards Night will be held in the Boulevard Room at Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre, Grey Street, South Brisbane on Saturday 27 October 2018

Requirements of award recipients

- Be available to participate in marketing and promotional activities in the 12 months following the awards; and
- Provide content for articles in Tennis Queensland publications upon reasonable request
