



The JDS Red Ball Championship incorporates a series of events specifically targeted at players of an *ANZ Hot Shots Red Ball level*, using a 25% compression ball. The RTC aims to engage young players who are beginning their journey in tennis with their first competitive match play experience. To achieve this, each tournament consists of a separate boys singles event and girls singles event, in the format of a compass draw which has been designed to ensure each player received a minimum of four (4) matches.

Venue	Date	Note -Competency
Range Tennis Club	6 March	Must be able to rally, underarm serve, score
Roma & District Tennis Club	12 July	Must be able to rally, underarm serve, score

<u>AGE</u>- Player eligibility is determined by their age as at day of each event. Each Red Ball event is open to players **aged EIGHT (8) years or younger.** If requested, a player must produce their birth certificate to an official or administrator.

EVENTS AT EACH TOURNAMENT

- GIRLS SINGLES
- BOYS SINGLES

ALL SINGLES MATCHES (excluding singles finals)

- The first player to reach 15 points will win the match.
- If the score reaches 14-14, the winner of the next point will win the match.
- Players will SERVE four (4) points in a row and CHANGE ENDS every eight (8) points.
 The two (2) players who reach the SINGLES FINAL will play a best of three (3) set match. A set will conclude when one (1) player wins 15 points.

- ACCEPTING the rules of the game
- POSITIVE ATTITUDE regardless of the score
- **ENJOYING** the tournament on and off and the court

ENTRY

Australian Ranking points ARE NOT affiliated with any Red Ball event within the South Region. Each Red Ball Tournament Circuit Event will provide players with the opportunity to earn points, which will be accumulated in a point's race.

Losing quarterfinalists or 5th to 8th placegetters	35
All other players	10
