CALL FOR BOARD NOMINATIONS – TENNIS QUEENSLAND

Please be advised that elections will be held for the following board positions at the upcoming Tennis Queensland (TQ) Annual General Meeting, to be held on Saturday 26 October 2019:

- One (1) Director position (three-year term)
- One (1) President position (three-year term)

With our very own Ashleigh Barty at the top of women's tennis, our sport in Queensland is enjoying a significant boost in profile and political support. In turn, Tennis Queensland is bolstering its regional focus by recruiting more team members throughout the state to support local tennis outcomes and build on our relationships with tennis delivery networks within the regions. Our strengthened workforce will assist affiliates, volunteers, coaches and teachers to deliver engaging social and competitive programs across the demographic spectrum. Queensland is close to achieving the significant milestone of 175,000 participants playing the game, which is testament to an alignment of vision between the state's tennis administrators and clubs.

Beyond ensuring the good governance of the organisation, elected Directors will play a significant role overseeing the implementation of our strategy as well as supporting our staff, volunteers and stakeholders through new opportunities and challenges as we work to engage more Queenslanders in our sport.

This is a terrific opportunity for strong leaders who can evidence a genuine interest and passion for advancing the sport of tennis in Queensland and what he/she can contribute. Consequently, the current Tennis Queensland Board has developed a list of skills (refer to point c below) needed to supplement the expertise of our existing directors and to help navigate the short and long term strategic challenges and opportunities.

Nominees should complete and return the following requirements to nominate:

- a. TQ Director or President 3-year term nomination form
- b. Covering letter and Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- c. Actual, potential or perceived conflicts of interest you have with Tennis Queensland and what measures you intend taking to mitigate them
- d. (Optional) The Board has considered the preferred mix of skills and also identified areas where the TQ Board should ideally be strengthened. To assist in the assessment of nominations by Members, please provide information regarding how the applicant's skills and experience might fulfil any of the following specific skill sets:
 - a. Passion a genuine interest and passion in advancing the sport of tennis in Queensland
 - b. Strategy strategic thinking and experience with developing and delivering on strategic plans and objectives
 - c. Mentoring experience in mentoring and developing organizational capability and capacity
 - d. Risk an understanding of risk management and planning
 - e. Financial literacy accountancy qualifications or a strong ability to understand financial statements and arrangements
 - f. Government experience / understanding knowledge of and/or contacts in local, State or Federal government, especially in relation to funding of projects

- g. Business networks strong corporate / business and sporting relationships and experience in fostering these relationships to assist the sport and attract partnerships and sponsorships
- h. Industry Knowledge experience with developing and running sporting clubs and centres

Location and Time Commitment: The Board currently meets six times each year. Board sub-committees also meet 2-6 times a year. All board and sub-committee meetings are held at the Queensland Tennis Centre (QTC) at Tennyson in Brisbane.

Remuneration: This is a voluntary role.

Appointment Process: The closing date for all applications is 5pm Friday 13 September 2019. Following receipt of all applications we will arrange for interviews with candidates in September. The successful candidates will be appointed by the end of October. All candidates will have the opportunity to receive feedback on their application.
