The Queensland Junior Teams Carnival will be held from the **12 to the 16 December 2015** (inclusive). It is the most grueling yet most enjoyable event on the junior tennis calendar, and is the largest team event in Queensland.

Featuring singles, doubles and mixed doubles, plus the separate **Gold Junior Tour singles event**, the Queensland Junior Teams Carnival is the biggest and the best!

We believe the South's mix of enthusiastic junior players from the Junior Development Series as well as our own outstanding Australian Ranked players have a great opportunity in becoming Queensland Team Champions in 2015.

Selection Criteria:

Players will need to be registered members with Tennis Queensland. Teams will be selected by the South Regional Assembly based on players' Australian ranking and Junior Development Series points ranking. There will be one team per age group (11/u, 13/u, 15/u and 17/u divisions) to represent the South against the other regions of Queensland.

Nominations to be a part of the South team are **now open** but close on **Friday 7 November 2015**.

*** Important Note: You must nominate to make the team (even if you finish highest on JDS points table)**

Event Information

Event date: 12 to the 16 December 2015

Format: is likely to be the same as last year:

- Each team (6 players) will play at least one session per day (times to be confirmed)
- Two teams (A and B) in each age division
- Additional individual singles competition held open to all players wishing to compete
- In each session the team plays a "Match" (which consists of 8 rubbers):
 - 1 girls doubles
 - 1 boys doubles
 - 2 mixed doubles
 - 2 girls singles
 - 2 boys singles (preferably played in this order)
