## Brisbane International Schools' Challenge

The Brisbane International Schools Challenge is a mixed team competition for Queensland primary schools. Each school has the opportunity to nominate one or more teams at Regional ties throughout Queensland. Winners at each tie are then invited to compete at the State final to be held at Brisbane International 2017.

## Teams

Each team must consist of four to five players. Teams can be made up of a mixture of boys and girls or can be solely boys or girls. Players can only enter in either the orange or the green ball competition.

All teams must play in school uniforms, with hats being compsulsory for participation.

Players need to be ranked in order of their singles ability.

## Cost

Teams must pay a fee of $\$ 60$ (incl. GST) to participate in the Regional ties. Payments must be received via direct deposit prior to the competition. No additional cost will be incurred for participation at the State Final.

## About

The matches are played using a modified ball and equipment suitable for each age group of competition.

## Schedule

Please make sure you arrive in time to attend the managers meeting at 8.40 am . All ties will be played in a timeframe between $9 \mathrm{am}-3 \mathrm{pm}$ depending on the number of entries.


## Competition \& Court Size

Orange event (Grade 5 and below)
$-50 \%$ compression orange balls
-courts with reduced 10.29 m length and 6.4 m width -winners from all regional ties qualify for State Finals (5 January 2017)

## Green event (Grade 6 and below)

$-75 \%$ compression green balls
-full courts
-winners and runners-up from all regional ties qualify for the State Final (6-8 January 2017)

## Format

All matches are played using FAST4 format. Each team is guaranteed to play at least three matches on the day. Teams play four singles and two doubles rubbers where possible. The format may be shortened to two doubles rubbers in case not enough courts are available. Each rubber will be played as a FAST4 set:

- first to 4 games
- tie-breaker at 3 games all
- no ad-scoring
- play lets

For more information on rules and player eligibility please refer to the rules of the competition.

## Software

All ties will be run using the new Tennis competition software. Players will be able to access their results online at www.leagues.tennis.com.au

## State Final

The State Final will be from 5-8 January 2017 at the Queensland Tennis Centre during the Brisbane International. Players must be available for all days of competition. Players, the team manager and a parent will receive accreditation.

More information on the final will be delivered to qualified team after the regional events.
