

Coaching Excellence – Club

This award recognises coaches that work within their local communities. The coach provides quality coaching programs, is actively involved in growing the game and provides competition opportunities for players to progress their game.

Selection Criteria & Nomination Process

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for consideration, the nominee must:

- Be a current ANZ Tennis Hot Shots Coach and Tennis Australia qualified coach member
- Be delivering quality coaching programs and providing pathways which cater for the needs of players within their community;
- Have a strong relationship with the club/facility committee/management;
- Be actively involved in his/her club/facility in growing the game of tennis;
- Actively seek positive relationships with local schools and the general community; and
- Provide opportunities for players to move from coaching programs to competitions and tournaments

Part-time and full-time coaches may apply.

Selection criteria

In order to be given consideration by the selection panel, the below selection criteria will need to be addressed.

Note: information regarding the athlete's and coach's program will remain confidential and will only be seen by the selection panel.

2	Roles and responsibilities at club/centre
3	Contribution to club/community

5	Overview of the transition pathway for coaching participants to Leagues and Tournaments
6	Number of National Schools Partnership Program schools and overview of transition pathway from schools to club and coaching programs
7	Qualifications of coaching staff and professional development opportunities accessed and provided for staff
8	Coaching business website, marketing material and communication materials

Selection process

- Nominees should attach any relevant additional information with their nomination form
- All entries must supply a minimum of three (3) high-resolution photos and/or video footage supporting their nomination. Please be aware of size limitations if submitting via email – if required please use alternative data-sharing methods to submit such as Dropbox or USB.
- Only information provided with the nomination form will be considered by the selection panel
- You must consult with a Tennis Queensland staff member and have them sign off on your application before final submission

All decisions in relation to the award (including any questions in relation to eligibility) will be determined by a selection panel in its absolute discretion. All decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Timeline

- Nominations close – Midnight Monday 4 September 2017
- Finalists announced – Week commencing Friday 29 September 2017
- The Tennis Queensland Awards Night will be held in the Boulevard Room at Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre, Grey Street, South Brisbane on Saturday 28 October 2017

Requirements of award recipients

- Be available to participate in marketing and promotional activities in the 12 months following the awards; and
- Provide content for articles in Tennis Queensland publications upon reasonable request
