Most Outstanding 35+ Senior

The mission of 35+ Seniors tennis is to increase the playing opportunities and social interaction for tennis players of all standards over age 35. This award recognises involvement in 35+ Seniors tennis as a player or administrator or both. The recipient of this award has been involved in raising the public profile of 35+ seniors tennis through demonstrated excellence in playing performance, or administration and demonstrated behaviours that exhibit a high level of integrity.

Selection Criteria & Nomination Process

Eligibility criteria

• Open to male and female players and administrators who are or have been members of Tennis Seniors Australia and registered to Tennis Australia

Nominees may self-nominate or be nominated by another person (note: if you self-nominate you will require a seconder to support your nomination)

Selection criteria

In order to be given consideration by the selection panel, the below selection criteria will need to be addressed.

No.	Description
1	Continued involvement in 35+ Tennis Seniors over a prolonged period of time whether it be as a player, administrator or both
2	Assisted in raising the public profile of 35+ Seniors Tennis through demonstrated excellence in playing performance, or administration or both
3	Demonstrated behaviours that exhibit a high level of integrity

Selection process

- Nominees should attach any relevant additional information with their nomination form
- All entries must supply a minimum of three (3) high-resolution photos and/or video footage supporting their nomination. Please be aware of size limitations if submitting via email – if required please use alternative datasharing methods to submit such as Dropbox or USB.
- Only information provided with the nomination form will be considered by the selection panel
- You must consult with a Tennis Queensland staff member and have them sign off on your application before final submission

All decisions in relation to the award (including any questions in relation to eligibility) will be determined by a selection panel in its absolute discretion. All decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Timeline

- Nominations close Midnight Monday 4 September 2017
- Finalists announced Week commencing Friday 29 September 2017
- The Tennis Queensland Awards Night will be held in the Boulevard Room at Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre, Grey Street, South Brisbane on Saturday 28 October 2017

Requirements of award recipients

- Be available to participate in marketing and promotional activities in the 12 months following the awards; and
- Provide content for articles in Tennis Queensland publications upon reasonable request

Nominations must be submitted to Tennis Queensland by Monday 4 September 2017
