

Most Outstanding Tournament

The Most Outstanding Tournament is selected from a Pro Tour, Australia Money Tournament, Junior Tour or Junior Development Series event. These events are stepping stones for players to develop their games. The recipient of this award will have offered a complete package of on- and off-court activities and player amenities to a high standard allowing for a positive tournament atmosphere and implemented strategies to engage local sponsors, media attention and community involvement.

Selection Criteria & Nomination Process

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for consideration for the Most Outstanding Tournament, the tournament must show that it:

- Is a Pro Tour, Australian Money Tournament, Junior Development Series or Junior Tour event
- Is a sanctioned event and is affiliated with Tennis Queensland
- Has undertaken media and promotional activities
- Has complied with all rules and regulations as set by Tennis Australia, Tennis Queensland and/or the International Tennis Federation
- Has offered players social activities and player amenities to a high standard allowing for a positive tournament atmosphere
- Implemented strategies to engage the local community with the tournament
- Obtained sponsorship for the tournament and implemented strategies to service these sponsors
- Fully utilised the Tournament Planner (TP) software program and Active Network online registration system in coordinating their tournament (relevant only to AMT and JT events)
- Have a pro-active tournament committee

Nominees may self-nominate or be nominated by another person (note: if you self-nominate you will require a seconder to support your nomination)

Selection criteria

In order to be given consideration by the selection panel, the below selection criteria will need to be addressed.

No.	Description
1	The type, volume and level of success of media and promotional activities undertaken
2	The type of social activities and the standard of player amenities provided, and how this contributed to a positive tournament atmosphere
3	The type and success of strategies engaging the local community with the tournament
4	The standard of the tournament sponsorship program and the level of service provided to the sponsors
5	The level of pro-activity shown by the tournament committee and the success of the pro-active actions
6	Demonstrated leadership, innovation and creativity overall
7	All entries must supply a minimum of three high-resolution photos and/or video footage supporting their nomination.

Selection process

- Nominees should attach any relevant additional information with their nomination form
- All entries must supply a minimum of three (3) high-resolution photos and/or video footage supporting their nomination. Please be aware of size limitations if submitting via email – if required please use alternative data-sharing methods to submit such as Dropbox or USB.
- Only information provided with the nomination form will be considered by the selection panel

All decisions in relation to the award (including any questions in relation to eligibility) will be determined by a selection panel in its absolute discretion. All decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Timeline

- Nominations close – Midnight Monday 4 September 2017
- Finalists announced – Week commencing Friday 29 September 2017
- The Tennis Queensland Awards Night will be held in the Boulevard Room at Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre, Grey Street, South Brisbane on Saturday 28 October 2017

Requirements of award recipients

- Be available to participate in marketing and promotional activities in the 12 months following the awards; and
- Provide content for articles in Tennis Queensland publications upon reasonable request

Nominations must be submitted to Tennis Queensland by Monday 4 September 2017
