## 2023 and 2024 events

The only existing team's championship event on the calendar, this event features a maximum of 12 teams in each age group ( 1 per Australian state/territory) plus a maximum of 4 invited international teams. 3 players and 1 manager are selected to represent the state/territory/country. The $11 / \mathrm{u} \& 13 / \mathrm{u}$ event is played over the first 5 days, followed by the $15 / \mathrm{u}$ event over the next 4 days.

- Dates: Term 2 school holidays (June/July)
- Draw size: Maximum of 12 teams
- Events: Singles and Doubles
- Length of Event: 11 days ( 9 match days, 2 practice days)
- Surface: Hardcourt or Claycourt
- Minimum Number of Courts required: 18 (practice courts throughout event in addition to this)
- Venue Requirements: Tournament Office, PA System, Physio room, Changerooms/Toilets
- Court Requirements: Meet minimum TA guidelines in terms of playing area.
- Courts Lights (minimum lux preferred)
- Chair Umpires from SF onwards (maximum of 8 courts)
- Player chairs, singles sticks, $3 / 4$ or full-size nets and appropriate court-drying equipment
- Minimum Economic Impact
- \$550,000+
