The annual Queensland Tennis Awards is an opportunity to recognise the achievements and contributions of athletes, clubs, coaches, officials, volunteers, and individuals who have made an outstanding impact on tennis in Queensland.

This guide will assist in completing the 2025 Queensland Tennis Award nominations, outlining the Tennis Queensland (TQ) timelines, process, conditions of nomination, guidance on completion of the nomination forms and criteria for the open award categories.

- The successful recipients will be required to fulfill the following items upon reasonable request:
  - o Photos and interviews at the Queensland Tennis Awards
  - o Participate in marketing and promotional activities in the 12 months following the Awards
  - o Participate in tennis pilot programs and initiatives, where applicable

### Newcombe Medal, Australian Tennis Awards

• Where applicable and eligible, selected winners of the 2025 Queensland Tennis Awards will be nominated for the 2025 Newcombe Medal, Australian Tennis Awards.

### **Selection Panel**

- The selection panel will be made up of area specialists and independent members.
- The selection panel in its absolute discretion will determine all decisions.

# NOMINATION FORM GUIDE

The following are required fields for all open award nominations. One <u>Nomination Form</u> is to be completed per nomination.

Please note there is a character limit of 1,200 applied to each open text field, however these fields have rich text formatting enabled, allowing bullet points, hyperlinks, etc.

# **Application**

- The award period for the 2025 Queensland Tennis Awards is September 2024 August 2025.
- Nominations will only be accepted through internal assessment or the online form.
- Contact details provided as part of nominations will be used to forward correspondence to nominees advising selection as finalists and invitations to the Awards.
- Online nominations must include a minimum of three high-resolution images, which accurately reflect the nominee and will be used in promotional material should the nominee be selected as a finalist.
- Nominees must demonstrate a high level of integrity, which will be considered when assessing nominations.
- Claims made in nomination forms must be true and correct.
- TQ reserve the right to enter nominees for the awards.
- TQ reserve the right to withdraw a category or cancel an award if an insufficient number of nominations are received, the quality of nominations does not meet the criteria, or the nominations are deemed inappropriate for any reason.
- TQ reserve the right to withdraw a nomination based on any outstanding integrity issues.
- All nominations should reflect activities over the past 12 months.
- TQ accept no responsibility for nominations that are not received, delayed, incomplete or are lost due to a technical problem.
- TQ reserve the right to use nomination images and information during Queensland Tennis Awards marketing and promotion.
