Club and Security

If you are the last person (or group) to leave the courts or club rooms please lock up! If there are players using courts 3 and 4 (the bottom courts) it is a good idea to check to determine if they want the club rooms left open, otherwise lock up!

Paying for Lights

Now that the days are getting shorter please ensure that all social and casual players make the required contribution for lights before leaving. If you are only using one court it is recommended that you turn on both sets of lights e.g. if you are playing on court 1 turn on the lights for courts 1 and 2 - the fee is still \$5.00 per hour.
