6 game sets for all matches

Doubles matches must be played first. The number one singles player must play in the top double.

Eligibility

Senior Team event eligibility

- Any player who has lived in a regional area and played tennis in a regional association in the past two
 years is eligible to play in the Country Carnival teams event, however, each team is only allowed to
 have one player in this category
- Players who live in a regional area and play tennis only in a metro association are eligible to play the Country Carnival team's event, however, each team is only allowed to have one player in this category.

Junior Team event eligibility

- Players can compete in the junior team's event provided they reside in a regional area and have either competed in a regional association in the current summer period or are not playing competition tennis at all.
- Players who represent a regionally based team in a metro association competition are allowed to compete in the Country Carnival team's event.
- The cute off date for the Teams Event is January 31 2022.
