Withdrawal deadline and Late Withdrawal Rule – A player is permitted four (4) Late Withdrawal and/or Failure to Complete Match or Tournament violations in a calendar year without incurring disciplinary points. Entering two tournaments at the same time – An athlete may enter and play a draw (including qualifying draws) in different events where any of the dates of those events overlap, however they must complete all commitments to the earlier event by the day before their first match of the second event that has been scheduled. Under no circumstances can an athlete be an active participant in two overlapping events on the same day.
