



Tennis SA – Memorial Drive, North Adelaide Court Hire - Terms Of Use

We aim to make your booking and tennis experience as easy and straightforward as possible, so it's important that you take a little time to read the following terms & conditions of using our venue for tennis court hire.

Availability of Courts

The Memorial Drive Tennis Centre ("centre courts") and clay courts are not available for public recreational use, unless approved in writing by the Tennis SA CEO, or his/her nominated delegate.

When the courts are not booked for approved programs and events, all National Squad players may have access to the centre, STF or clay courts at no charge for a maximum of 2 hours. Bookings must be made and a refundable deposit paid, the courts be clean and tidy following use and key returned.

Tennis purposes only

The facilities are only to be used for the purpose of recreational tennis. Professional coaching, competitions and events on the tennis courts may not take place, other than by approved persons, who have prior agreement with the Tennis SA CEO, or his/her nominated delegate. No person or body is permitted to use the venue for any other activity without written agreement from the Tennis SA CEO, or his/her nominated delegate prior to use.

Access to the venue

Access to the tennis courts will be only be permitted for the court and times stated within your booking confirmation.

All users required to collect a key from the Tennis SA Reception during Business Hours only. A cash deposit of \$100 is required for key – refunded upon return of key and satisfactory condition of courts following use.

Compulsory Maintenance Before and After Use

Clay Courts

At the start and end of each session, the courts must be bagged then watered.

Bagging the courts is done by one person dragging a sweeping mat across the court or up/down the court, keeping the mat flat with the court surface at all times. In heavy traffic areas (e.g. baselines), extra bagging in a figure 8 pattern is recommended. Courts to be bagged even if not in use.

Following bagging, the courts must be watered (this will depend on moisture levels of the court and weather conditions). Spread water evenly from fence to fence so that the clay is visibly wet without being flooded. Do not point the hose directly at the court surface or hose the same area for too long.

Centre and STF Courts

At the start and end of each session, the courts must be clear of all obstacles and rubbish.

Court Hire Fees

- Centre - fee as determined by management to be paid at time of key collection.
- STF - \$10.00 per hour) to be paid at time of key collection or via the online booking system (Book a Court).
- Clay - \$15.00 per hour to be paid at time of key collection.

All fees are doubled when lights are in use.

Refund Policy

You may cancel your booking by contacting the Tennis SA Reception during Business Hours.

In the case of late cancellations, inclement weather or other factors restricting your access to the courts, please contact the Tennis SA Reception during Business Hours to confirm the refund policy or arrange another time.

Tennis SA will have full discretion on whether a refund will be provided for any cancellations made within 24 hours of your booking.

Tennis SA reserves the right to cancel your bookings at any time, in the circumstances where the Tennis SA cancels your booking you will be offered an alternative booking time and/or be provided a refund for your booking.

Children

Children under the age of 16 must be supervised by an adult at all times whilst using the venue.

Safety

It is a condition that users of the tennis courts undertake to use the facilities in a safe and cautious manner at all times and acknowledge that use is at their own risk. By booking a court, and by providing your name and contact details, you are covered within Tennis Australia's national insurance program.

Smoking, alcohol or drugs is not permitted within the venue, including courts.
