What are Blended Lines?


- Permanent line markings for red and orange courts that can be added on to existing full size tennis court surfaces
- They create an environment where kids can learn to play tennis on smaller playing areas
- Blended Lines are approximately 3-4cm in width and can be painted over a standard tennis court using the same colour family as the playing surface in a lighter or darker shade





Benefits of Blended Lines

- The advantage of having Blended Lines is that you maintain the existing infrastructure required to service the needs of other participants such as
 - Coaching participants
 - Competition players
 - Social players
- Removes the need for drop down lines, which in turn reduces time setting and packing up courts
- Provides consistent court dimensions
- Professional competition look



Outcomes

- Improve the retention of children in tennis
- Build stronger links from schools to clubs
- Increased social play for casual players having access to modified courts
- Reduced volunteer burden of setting and packing up drop down lines
- Reduced financial burden to clubs buying and replacing drop down lines

- Increased venues delivering ANZ Tennis Hot Shots Match Play
- Increased efficiency of Tennis Australia accredited coaches

Project structure

- Open to all Tennis SA affiliated clubs that are willing to comply with the requirements of the National Court Rebate program
- Tennis SA will fund 75% of installation minimum of 2 and a maximum of 6 courts per venue
- Operational Health Check must be completed by club
- Priority will be given to ANZ Tennis Hot Shots Match Play venues (or willing to become one)
- Tennis SA will install blended lines to 100 courts in 100 days
- Blended Lines installation will provide 1 orange ball and 2 red ball courts per standard court
- Additional courts may be requested (at the discretion of Tennis SA)
- Does not include, and cannot be done in conjunction with, resurfacing or any other works
