TOURNAMENTS

What events have been postponed?

All Junior Development Series and Australian Ranking Tournaments including Australian Money Tournaments (AMT) and Junior Tournaments (JT) have been postponed.

For local events and tournaments that are not operated by Tennis SA, the decision for postponement or cancellation is at the discretion of the relevant Club, Association or Coach.

I run a tournament, what do I do?

We recognise these are very difficult decisions to make. We have made decisions based on the best medical advice available in the interests of public health.

What does this mean for the tournament I am entered in to?

All online entry mechanisms will be closed until further notice. If you are entered into a JDS, AMT or JT, refunds will be processed in the coming days.

Will tournaments during the Easter holidays go ahead?

All events operated by Tennis SA are postponed until further notice.

All Junior Development Series and Australian Ranking Tournaments including Australian Money Tournaments (AMT) and Junior Tournaments (JT) have been postponed.

For local events and tournaments that are not operated by Tennis SA, the decision for postponement or cancellation is at the discretion of the relevant Club, Association or Coach.

Will the 2020 12/u and 14/u Australian Claycourt Championships be postponed?

The 2020 12/u and 14/u Australian Claycourt Championships due to take place in Canberra from 3-8 April 2020 have been postponed.



COMPETITIONS

What events have been postponed?

Competitions operated by Tennis SA (including State League, Metro League, Junior State League and Green Ball State League) will not be played until further notice. If these competitions cannot be recommenced by Sunday 29 March, the team placed highest on the ladder will be deemed the winner.

For local competitions that are not operated by Tennis SA, the decision for postponement or cancellation is at the discretion of the relevant Club, Association or Coach.

I run a competition, what do I do?

We recognise these are very difficult decisions to make. We have made decisions based on the best medical advice available in the interests of public health.

COMMUNITY TENNIS ACTIVITIES

What are community tennis activities?

In South Australia, these are club based activities such as small group social tennis, Open Court Sessions, cardio tennis and coaching.

These activities can continue at the discretion of the Club, Association or Coach as long as hygiene guidelines are followed.

Associations and clubs within South Australia are referred to as Tennis SA Affiliated Associations and Clubs.
