**REMINDERS**

**TO ALL COORDINATORS - VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

**\*Please make sure that all your team managers, players & parents are aware of the following:-**

1. **10&U – GREEN DOT balls** are compulsory for all 10&U League Grades. Clubs purchase their own.
2. **BY-LAWS** – Make sure you have the **CURRENT** by-laws.
3. **ORDER OF PLAY** – Everyone must be aware of the changes to our 2016/17 '**ORDER OF PLAY**'
4. **PERMITS** – By-Law 19, please be aware of the rules, if in doubt, please contact Heather Lees
5. **HOME COURTS** – Make sure you know the correct **HOME COURTS** (see bottom of draw)
6. **GENERAL BYE** – Please make note: **SATURDAY 29th OCTOBER** (Melbourne Cup)
7. **FINALS** – Both finals are on the **SAME WEEKEND**, Semi Final SAT 18<sup>th</sup> March & Grand Final SUN 19<sup>th</sup> March

**EXPLANATION of Supervising Adult Role:** (C D E/F Association, SDV2&3 League grades)

\*Supervise from the umpire chair or the net if a chair is not available.

\*Watch the game and keep score, either mentally or written.

(Do not call the score out after each point; the "server" shall call out the score after each point)

\*Oversee the game and clarify if players are confused.

\*Over-rule incorrect line calls.

\*In the unlikely event of intimidation or cheating occurring, teams can ask the supervising adult to Umpire & Score.

(This can also apply to A & B Association and SDV1 League grades)

\*10&U matches to be umpired by the duty parent.

**\*Team Supervisors are to remain at the courts during the entire match.**

**(The younger & or less experienced players will require some assistance, but for consistency we ask that the supervising parents comply with the above)**

**SERVING**

Team Supervisors should be reminded that all players (including 10&U) are to serve in the proper manner.

Underarm serves are permitted, but bouncing the ball before striking is NOT PERMITTED.

**SUDDEN DEATH @ Deuce**

This applies to **League DDV2, 10&U grades** (ie: winner of the next point wins the game)
