## How to Play a Tiebreaker

### A TIE BREAKER WILL BE PLAYED AT 5-5 ALL IN A & B GRADES ONLY.

A tie-breaker consists of a minimum of seven (7) points.

The player or players who first wins seven points shall win the set, provided they lead by a margin of two (2) points.

The player whose turn it is to serve shall be the server for the *first point*, and is to server from the forehand side (one point, two balls).

Thereafter, each player shall serve in rotation for *two points*, starting from the backhand side, in the same order as previously in that set, until the winners of the game and set have been decided.

Players shall change ends every six points (the player who serves the sixth point from the left hand court, then serves from the right court from the other end).

**NOTE:**

Odd points will be served from the *right hand court*.

Even points will be served from the *left hand court*.
