Current Club improvements

You may have noticed the recent work to upgrade the Club facilities. Our ongoing maintenance and upgrading has included:

- replacing unsafe stairs leading from the top bank to the Clubhouse
- garden weeding and tidying up
- levelling and resurfacing the area adjacent to court 4
- improving fencing to a number of courts
- repairing base lines in court 1
- erection of shade cloth over the deck (donated by Paul Kitchener)

While some of this work was undertaken by professionals, maintenance of facilities relies heavily on volunteers. All Club members can contribute in some way - can you spare a few hours to help with maintaining your Club?

Grant Application

The Club has applied for a grant from Sport and Recreation Tasmania's Major Grant Program for funds to resurface court 1 and widen the adjacent entrance path to comply with accessibility requirements. The anticipated total project cost is \$39 836 (inclusive of GST), with SRT funding up to 50% of the cost. The outcome will be known in May.

From the Treasurer

As at 31 January 2014, the Club had a balance of \$22 086.63. These funds will principally be used to upgrade Club facilities and Tennis Tasmania membership registrations. The Club still has an outstanding loan for previous improvements which is now under \$13 000.
