

OUTSTANDING ATHLETE WITH A DISABILITY SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for consideration for the Outstanding Athlete With A Disability award, the nominee must be:

- A citizen or hold permanent residency of Australia.
- Has competed in a minimum of three (3) tournaments in the calendar year (applicable to disability)

THE NOMINATION PROCESS FOR AUSTRALIAN TENNIS AWARD

 The winners of the State Award for Outstanding Athlete With A Disability will become the nominee for the National Award for Outstanding Athlete With A Disability. Finalists will be invited to attend the Newcombe Medal Award ceremony in November

SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominations:

- Improvements in ranking over a 12 month period
- Representation record playing for school, club, state/country (if applicable);
- Examples of appropriate and commendable attitude, commitment and respect

PROCESS

Nominations open

1 July - 20 August

• Selection panel confirms finalists

27 August

• Finalists notified

3 September

Award recipient announced

18 September at Tennis Tasmania Awards Event
