



MOST OUTSTANDING CLUB SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for consideration for the Most Outstanding Club award, the club must be:

- Affiliated with a Member Association (MA)
- Employs/engages qualified Tennis Australia coach members or is a Community Play Venue.
- Has completed the Tennis Australia Operational Health Check
- Has implemented Tennis Australia participation programs and competitions providing a range of opportunities to the whole community
- Has actively engaged with underrepresented groups (ie. people with disabilities, Indigenous Australians, multicultural communities, lower socio-economic communities, people who identify as LGBTI) to ensure the club is inclusive for diverse communities.
- Uses a range of Tennis (or equivalent) systems, e.g: My Tennis, League Manager, Tournaments Planner
- Is accessible to the broader community, allowing for public court hire
- Has a partnership with a local school through the School Partnership Program or School Play Program
- Has shown initiative and innovation during a challenging year to ensure tennis opportunities have continued to be available to the community

THE NOMINATION PROCESS FOR AUSTRALIAN TENNIS AWARD

The winners of the State Award for Most Outstanding Club will become a nominee for the National Award for Most Outstanding Club. Finalists will be invited to attend the Newcombe Awards in Melbourne

SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominations:

- Demonstration of participation growth
- Examples of future planning strategies
- Accessibility and access to the whole community
- Direct customer feedback
