
TENNIS TASMANIA ANZ TENNIS HOT SHOT MATCH PLAY RED BALL GUIDELINES

1. COURT & BALL MODIFICATIONS:

Red Ball Match Play

Court Size	Net Height	Ball
11m x 5.5m wide for singles and doubles.	67-80cm	The Red ball is to be used (which is 25% compression of a full compression Yellow ball)



2. RED BALL FORMAT

- To begin, players rock/paper/scissors and the winner chooses to serve or receive.
- Matches last 15 minutes, with players to play as many points possible throughout this time.
- > Rotation of serve will be every four points.
- Players will change ends every eight points.
- > After allocated 15 minute ends, players are to record their total team points on the scorecard.
- If players fail to serve the ball over the net twice, they are allowed a third serve (donkey drop) which must land in the correct service box.
- Players must serve cross court diagonal, starting on the right side of the court, second point from left side of the court.
- At the end of the match, players must shake hands with their opposition and thank them for the match.

3. MATCH DAY

- ➤ Players are expected to be at the venue 10 minutes before their match commences.
- > Before walking to court, all players should know their allocated court and playing partners.
- When the whistle sounds, players are to begin matches until the 15-minute time limit is up.
- After the whistle blows again, matches finish. Players will record their total number of points on the scoresheet and find their next teammate to play another doubles match.
- Parents are welcome to assist with scoring on court if required.
- After all three matches are completed, scoresheets are to be handed to the coach coordinator.
- If players are unable to attend, it is their responsibility to contact their coach coordinator.
