ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for consideration for the Excellence in Officiating award, the nominee must be:

- Be 18 years or over as at the beginning of the award period
- Be a citizen of, or hold permanent residency in Australia
- Be a TA Officials Member
