# Coaching Excellence Tennis Tasmania



## Selection criteria and process

### Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for consideration, the nominee must:

- Be a current Tennis Australia qualified or business coach member
- Nominees may be internal Tennis Australia Coaching Staff or external Development Coaches
- All nominees must have completed appropiate screening\*
- Be a ANZ Tennis Hot Shot program deliver
- Be deliving quality coaching programs and providing holistic pathways which cater for the needs of players within the community
- Have a strong relationship with the club/facility committee/management
- Be actively involved in his/her club/facility in growing the game of tennis;
- Actively seek postivie relationships with local schools and the general community;
- Provide opportunities for player to move from coaching programs to copeitions and tournaments; and
- Contribution to making Tennis more welcoming and inclusive

\*Appropriate screenings include:

- Required:
  - Working With Children Check relevant to your state or territory
- Preferred:
  - It is preferred that a National Police Check accompanies the WWC.

#### The nomination process for Tasmanian Tennis Award

- The winners of the State Award for Coaching Excellence (or equivalent) will become the nominee for the National Award for Coaching Excellence
- The national body reserves the right to enter wild card nominees for this award
