

Selection criteria and process

Eligibility criteria

- Nominees must be over 18 years as at the start of the award period;
- Nominees must be a citizen of, or hold permanent residency on Australia.

Selection criteria

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominees:

No.	Description	
1	Commendable ranking level (ATP/WTA/ITF/AR);	
2	Demonstrated record representing club, school, state/country	
3	Appropriate and commendable attitude in-line with our player values of Compete, Commit and Respect; and	
4	Has complied with all rules and conducts set by Tennis Australia	

Note: The award period is from 11 August 2016 – 11 August 2017. Only achievements/details from this period will be considered by the panel

Selection process

All decisions in relation to the Junior Athlete of the Year award (including any questions in relation to eligibility) will be determined by the selection panel in its absolute discretion. All decisions are final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

Any matters which arise and which are not covered in this document will be determined by the selection panel in consultation with Tennis Tasmania management.
