Format / Teams / Scoring

- All players must be 10 or younger as of 1st December, 2020
- Singles: One 50-minute singles match
 - 1vs1, 2vs2, 3vs3, 4vs4
- Doubles: One 50 minute doubles match
 - 1/2 VS 1/2 & 3/4 VS 3/4
- All scoring will be using the Fast 4 format with rules as follows;
 - Sets to 4 – Tie break at 3-3
 - 5 point tie break – At 4-4 a sudden death point is played to win set
 - No advantage scoring – At 40-40, receiver chooses service side
- Teams will be comprised of players from throughout the South region, competing as a team with a designated coach
- Each week will host a theme with a specific technical and/or tactical focus based on the Super 10s award cards

Super 10s fees

- Players must register online and pay a fee of \$100 for the season (\$20 per round plus camp).
 - For the \$100 fee, players receive a New Balance t-shirt along with five rounds of competition and a talent development camp.

Wet weather contingency plan

- In the event of inclement weather washing out a whole match, Sunday will be used for make-up matches. In the event inclement weather washes out part of a round, this may be made up during future weeks.

Regional Challenge Cup

- At the conclusion of the Super 10s competition, standout boys and girls will be selected to represent their region at the upcoming Regional Challenge (date/location TBA). Players will be selected to represent their region based on performance/participation in Super 10s, Tasmanian Junior League, Junior Development Series as well as behaviour, attitude (willingness to compete), focused on development and sportsmanship.
