

# EXCELLENCE IN OFFICIATING SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

To be eligible for consideration for the Excellence in Officiating award, the nominee must be:

- Be 18 years or over as at the beginning of the award period
- Be a citizen of, or hold permanent residency in Australia
- Be a TA Officials Member

## THE NOMINATION PROCESS FOR AUSTRALIAN TENNIS AWARD

The winners of the State Award Excellence in Officiating will become a nominee for the National Award for Excellence in Officiating. Finalists will be invited to attend the Newcombe Awards in Melbourne.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominees:

- Outstanding contributions to tennis officiating in Australia and/or Internationally through their dedication, skill, attitude and knowledge;
- Performances that set them apart from their peers domestically and/or internationally; and
