



## **OUTSTANDING ATHLETE WITH A DISABILITY**

### **SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS**

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

To be eligible for consideration for the Outstanding Athlete with A Disability award, the nominee must be:

- A citizen or hold permanent residency of Australia.
- Has competed in a minimum of three (3) tournaments in the calendar year (applicable to disability)

#### **THE NOMINATION PROCESS FOR AUSTRALIAN TENNIS AWARD**

The winners of the State Award for Outstanding Athlete with A Disability will become the nominee for the National Award for Outstanding Athlete with A Disability. Finalists will be invited to attend the Newcombe Awards in Melbourne.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominations:

- Improvements in ranking over a 12 month period
- Representation record playing for school, club, state/country (if applicable)
- Examples of appropriate and commendable attitude, commitment and respect
