



## **MOST OUTSTANDING CLUB SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS**

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

To be eligible for consideration for the Most Outstanding Club award, the club must be:

- Affiliated with a Member Association (MA)
- Employs/engages qualified Tennis Australia coach members or is a Community Play Venue
- Has implemented Tennis Australia participation programs and competitions providing a range of opportunities to the whole community
- Creates a positive culture of inclusiveness and care including opportunities for participation by all
- Uses a range of Tennis (or equivalent) systems, e.g. Clubspark, League Manager, Tournaments Planner
- Has court hire available online (e.g. via Book a Court/Clubspark or other platform) for all courts, for members and non-members alike.
- Has shown initiative and innovation during a challenging year to ensure tennis opportunities have continued to be available to the community

### **THE NOMINATION PROCESS FOR AUSTRALIAN TENNIS AWARD**

The winners of the State Award for Most Outstanding Club will become a nominee for the National Award for Most Outstanding Club. Finalists will be invited to attend the Newcombe Awards in Melbourne.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominations:

- Demonstration of participation growth
- Examples of future planning strategies
- Accessibility and access to the whole community
- Direct customer feedback
