



MOST OUTSTANDING SCHOOL SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for consideration for the Most Outstanding School award, the school must demonstrate:

- Tennis is incorporated into the health and physical education curriculum via the School Partnership Program or other means
- A Tennis Australia qualified coach is connected with the school
- Tennis is supported by the principal and driven by the teachers
- Links between the school, coach and local club
- Intra and/or inter school competition pathway is being developed or delivered

THE NOMINATION PROCESS FOR AUSTRALIAN TENNIS AWARD

The winners of the State Award for Most Outstanding School will become a nominee for the National Award for Most Outstanding School. Finalists will be invited to attend the Newcombe Awards in Melbourne.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominations:

- Provide examples of how committed and active the school has been in demonstrating their support and promotion of tennis into the school environment including teachers
- Examples of how active the school has been with initiatives set up to enhance the sport at a local community level;
- Demonstration of an increase in the number of students participating
- Provide examples of how the school promotes and communicates messages to the school community around their participation in tennis
- How the school provides a pathway for opportunities to go to the next level (community, competition and elite)
