



MOST OUTSTANDING TENNIS SENIOR 30+ SELECTION CRITERIA AND PROCESS

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for consideration for the Most Outstanding Tennis Senior award, the player / administrator must be:

- A current member of Tennis Seniors Australia and registered with Tennis Australia

THE NOMINATION PROCESS FOR AUSTRALIAN TENNIS AWARD

The winners of the State Award for Most Outstanding Tennis Senior (30+) will become the nominee for the National Award for 30+ Tennis Senior of the Year award. Finalists will be selected to attend the Newcombe Awards in Melbourne.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominations:

- Continued involvement in 30+ Seniors Tennis over a prolonged period of time as a player, administrator or both
- Assisted in raising the public profile of 30+ Seniors Tennis through demonstrated excellence in playing performance, administration or both
- Demonstrated a high level of integrity in all circumstances, on and off the court
