Please see below By-Law 3.9.9.1 re Interrupted Matches and Section 5 Unplayable Courts attached.

3.9.9.1 INTERRUPTED MATCHES

If play has not commenced due to adverse weather, players and umpires are to remain at the courts until 12.30p.m. as, quite often, the weather has improved enough to then commence play. Otherwise, if a match has not commenced or is interrupted by bad weather and play is impossible to continue, the match must be completed by the Friday following the appointed day. The Competition Secretary must be advised of the rescheduled agreement. The winning team is to enter results in the CRS and the losing team to confirm results in the CRS immediately on completion of the rescheduled match. Players are not obligated to play on unplayable courts. See Section 5 for definition.

If your match is interrupted by the weather tomorrow, the Committee advise the two teams to play any unfinished sets, one at a time or together at whatever venue and time that is agreed upon by the players involved so long as the Midweek Committee has a result by Friday. The Committee also need to be advised of the decision.

Please take note:

1

If the committee has NOT called the match off, then a result must be reached, the higher team will NOT automatically go to the next final. This is only in the case of a total washout announced by the committee. You will know this on or before 8.30am on email and facebook. Please do not ask before then, as a decision will not have been made and if it is 8.40am then Tennis WILL go ahead.
