SUB can play in either set marked in grey, and only plays that ONE set. Please circle the number the SUB is next to their name, ie. player 1,2,3 or 4. If recorded on the sheet at the start of play, this player is required to play. Failure to do so will result in a forfeit.

As before the sub can only play in set 1 or set 2 and can play as player 1,2,3 or 4.

The score sheet now looks like this – please note that the numbers next to the sub now indicate where the sub played. Please circle the relevant number.

See example below where Vicky Winship played as player 4 in the second set for the home team and Glenda Callow played as player 2 in the first set for the away team.
