PLAYER DECLARATIONS

Player Declarations are not required from 30th January onwards, but players and spectators should be reminded that they are to behave within Government guidelines. (If we are forced into a more restricted method of play this may be looked at again, but everyone will be advised accordingly)

REGISTER OF ATTENDANCE

Everyone must still register their attendance at each venue they visit. Each club will have its own method of doing this, and if you are unsure of what this is, ask your opposition

USE OF CLUBROOMS

Use of Clubrooms is still at the discretion of each club. Toilets, of course, must still be available for use, based on approval from your relevant Council.

Afternoon Tea/Lunch is still not provided.

Any team receiving a forfeit (whether home or away) must enter the score sheet listing their team members and showing the result as a forfeit. - refer to by-law 3.5.5 for clarification.
