All players who compete in ITF World Tennis Tour Tournaments must have a valid IPIN and sign-up to the IPIN Online Service, for which an annual IPIN Fee is payable (US\$65.00 in 2019). Failure by a player to fulfil these requirements will result in the rejection of that player's entry.
