

2019 MINTER MCNAMEE CUP TEAMS EVENT

CONDITIONS AND NOTES:

1. The event will be a pool round robin tournament that is open to all Tennis Victoria Country Region across Victoria. Each region may enter one team to consist of 2 girls and 2 boys, who are 17 years of age and under as at the 28 February 2019.
2. This event is to be conducted in accordance with the laws of the game adopted by Tennis Australia and the tournament Rules and Regulations laid down by Tennis Victoria. The Tennis Australia & Member Associations Code of Behaviour will apply.
3. The tournament will be conducted at Kooyong Lawn TC, 489 Glenferrie Road, Kooyong.
4. Each player shall contest one singles match and a mixed doubles match, so the tie will consist of six matches. The matches will be a six game set, tie-breaker at 6 games all. All mixed doubles matches will be sudden death deuce, gender to gender serving.
5. The order of the team must be set on this entry form. Any team changes to the nominated order of players must be received in writing by Tennis Victoria prior to the event, but no later than the conclusion of the Team Managers' meeting on the 1st day.
6. The tournament will commence at 9.00am Saturday 9 February 2019.
7. The Tournament Manager and Referee shall have the entire control and management of the tournament upon commencement.

10. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS**
Each representative of a region must be a registered participant of a Tennis Victoria affiliated club within that region, as well as satisfying points 10.1.1 or 10.1.2.
 - 10.1.1 *Where a club is operational for 6 months of the year the representative will need to have played competition (either within that club or representing that club in an Association competition) within that region for 50% of the season.*
 - 10.1.2 *Where a club is operational for 12 months of the year the representative will need to have played competition tennis (either within that club or representing that club in an Association competition) within that region for 50% of the year.*

Players not meeting the eligibility criteria and seeking selection may apply in writing through their RTE – AP representative for special consideration through to Tennis Victoria staff and then this is referred to Tennis Victoria's Match Day Committee, whose decision, based on a simple majority will be final.
This request must be submitted prior to the entry deadline.
11. **TENNIS VICTORIA PLAYER REGISTRATION**
All entrants are to be current registered participants of Tennis Victoria.
12. All players and parents are to complete and sign the PLAYER DECLARATION FORM, which is available online.
13. Any dispute in regard to the Minter McNamee Cup should be directed to the Tournament Manager and/or Referee.



14. The tournament will be governed by:

- a) The ITF Rules of Tennis
- b) The ITF Duties & Procedures for Officials
- c) Tennis Australia Code of Behaviour
- d) Tennis Australia Dress & Equipment Regulations, noting that teams are encouraged to wear team clothing, which provided they reasonably comply with the Dress regulations will be approved for play.

15. EMERGENCY/SUBSTITUTE PLAYERS

Where emergency or substitute player(s) are needed to be used, those player(s) should be used for that entire tie/round and must meet the player eligibility conditions.
