

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHEN AND HOW DO I REGISTER?

If your child is already involved with an ANZ Tennis Hot Shots program, speak with the local coach or club coordinator about taking the next step and getting involved in an ANZ Tennis Hot Shots Match Play program. Alternatively, you can find your nearest venue at hotshots.tennis.com.au

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST AND HOW CAN I PAY?

Pricing varies between clubs and centres delivering the program. If you contact the coach or club, they will be able to advise you of their price and the different avenues to make payment.

IF I MISSED A COUPLE OF WEEKS, IS THERE A REDUCED FEE?

This varies between clubs and centres delivering the program. If you contact the coach or club, they will be able to advise you if this is an option or not.

ARE THEIR DIFFERENT TEAM OPTIONS AVAILABLE?

Yes, depending on the club or centre delivering the program they may have 2, 3 or 4 player team options available as well as all boys, all girls or mixed teams.

DOES THE PROGRAM CONSIST OF PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT?

Parents are not required to stay with their child, however depending on the club or centre, parent involvement may be required. This may consist of umpiring, scoring etc. We would recommend you speak to the coach or club to confirm responsibilities.

HOW LONG DOES THE PROGRAM RUN FOR?

Depending on the club or centre, programs may vary. However they generally run from anywhere between 4 – 9+ weeks, either at a centralized venue or via a home and away fixture.

DOES MY CHILD NEED TO HAVE PARTICIPATED IN COACHING?

It isn't mandatory to have received coaching prior to being involved in a Match Play program. However, it is recommended that a child would have received at least two terms of coaching where they can learn the game, before they can transition from learning to playing the game through ANZ Tennis Hot Shots Match Play.

WHAT EQUIPMENT DO I NEED FOR MY CHILD?

Your child will require a racquet and appropriate clothing / footwear, but the coach and club will provide other relevant equipment.

WHAT IS THE PRIME PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM?

ANZ Tennis Hot Shots Match Play is all about exposing children to a fun, friendly environment, whilst putting into practice the skills they have learnt.
