





MAKE TENNIS BALL CUPCAKES

Have you always wanted to make tennis ball cupcakes? We show you how!



INGREDIENTS

CUPCAKE

1/4 cup cocoa

1/2 cup caster sugar

3/4 cup plain flour 80g butter, chopped

2 teaspoons baking powder

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 180°C/160°C fan-forced.

Prepare 12 hole muffin tray.

Sift all dry ingredients into a mixing bowl.

Make a small well in the middle of the bowl and then add remaining ingredients.

Beat on low speed with an electric mixer until combined.

Place the mixture into the muffin tray until holes are half full.

Place muffin tray into the oven for 15-20 minutes or until a skewer inserted in centre comes out clean.

Stand for 5 minutes and then turn out to a wire rack to cool completely.

2 eggs ICING

1/2 cup milk

1 cup icing sugar 1 tablespoon water 1/4 teaspoon green food colouring White chocolate writing fudge (available from supermarkets)

ICING

Place icing sugar in a small bowl and mix the water and food colouring to a thick consistency.

Spread cupcake with icing.

Leave until it sets.

Once set, draw two arcs on each side of the cupcake with white chocolate writing fudge (so it resembles a tennis ball).



TIP: You can use pre-packet cake mixture!




