

2019 FRANK SEDGMAN CUP TEAMS EVENT

TEAM ENTRY FORM



Traralgon Tennis Association, 27 – 28 July 2019

EVENT REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The event will be a pool round robin tournament that is open to all Tennis Victoria Country Regions and Metropolitan Associations who may enter a team of 2 boys and 2 girls who are to be 11 years of age or under as at 31 July, 2019.
2. All players nominated must be a current registered participant of a club or centre affiliated with Tennis Victoria that is within their country tennis region or metropolitan association they are representing. It is the responsibility of the Regional Team Event Advisory Panel representative or metropolitan association to ensure that all players named on the team entry form meet the above eligibility.
3. This event shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of tennis adopted by Tennis Australia and Tennis Victoria's event regulations and conditions. The Tennis Australia & Member Associations Code of Behaviour, Disciplinary Policy and National Extreme Weather Policy will also apply.
4. The tournament will be conducted on the plexi-cushion courts at the Traralgon Tennis Association, Corner Franklin and Davidson St, Traralgon Victoria 3844.
5. Each round will consist of 4 singles matches and 2 mixed doubles matches with each player participating in one singles match and one mixed doubles match per round. Matches will be one 6 game set with a tiebreaker to be played at 6 games all. Mixed doubles matches shall be no -ad deuce, gender to gender serving. The Tournament Director reserves the right to change the format and / or category of play based on court availability, weather or number of team entries to ensure a timely finish for each day's play.
6. Any team changes to the nominated singles order of merit must be received in writing by Tennis Victoria prior to the event, but no later than the conclusion of the Team Manager's meeting on the morning of the 1st day.
7. The tournament will commence at 9.00am Saturday 27 July 2019.
8. The Tournament Director and Referee shall have the entire control and management of the tournament upon commencement.
9. Entries should be submitted to Tennis Victoria via email (lita.trimmings@tennis.com.au) by 5pm Monday 15 July 2019
10. All players and parents / guardians are to complete the player declaration form, which is available online.
11. Any dispute in regard to the Frank Sedgman Cup should be directed to the Tournament Director and/or Referee.
12. Pre-Event Emergency Players
 - a) Events held in country areas

Emergency players for events hosted in country regions must first be sourced from the host region to complete a team before the event commences. Emergency players must not make up more than 50% of the complete team. Any emergency player should meet the player eligibility conditions in reference to their age and home country region or metro association.

If the host region cannot supply an emergency, a player may be sourced from any other region or metro Association, provided that the emergency player still meets the player eligibility conditions in reference to their age and home country region or metro Association.

b) Events held in metro Melbourne areas

Emergency players for events hosted in the metro Melbourne area may be sourced from any metro Association or country region to complete a team before the event commences. Emergency players must not make up more than 50% of the complete team. Any emergency player must meet the player eligibility conditions in reference to their age and home country region or metropolitan association including age and gender.

13. During Event Emergency Players

If a player is unable to complete the set they are currently playing they will forfeit that set.

An emergency player (if available), may replace an injured player and they will be able to play any other un-played set(s) in the current round and any future round matches. The Tournament Director and Referee will determine at what stage of a round, any emergency player can commence.

Emergency players used during an event, must meet the age and gender eligibility and be of an appropriate playing standard. The playing standard of an emergency player must be comparable to the injured player they are replacing. This will be determined by the Tournament Director and Referee.

Emergency players cannot make up more than 50% of the team.

14. In the event of an appeal against any regional team event result or related matter, this must be made in writing and submitted to Tennis Victoria by the relevant RTE-Advisory Panel Representative or Metro Association Secretary, by 5pm within 2 working days of the conclusion of the event.
