How lucky and ever so grateful is Kids Tennis Foundation to have such fantastic support from so many wonderful and very generous organizations, companies and individuals!



## WOW ANTON!

The opportunity to work with the students of Fitzroy Primary School is one that is rewarding, not only in being able to present the sport of tennis as a fun, inclusive skills based activity, but also being present in the growth of the students as individuals over time. Mentoring the students in their development of fundamental physical & mental athletic responses, not only in the sport, but with their awareness of themselves, their fellow students & how to appropriately respond to various scenarios, is the most rewarding experience any coach of any sport can ask for. I have been working with the students now for a couple of years & I can attest to the growth I have witnessed in these young people as individuals & as a group. They began as the excited, chaotic, uncoordinated kids that we all were & have over time developed not just tennis skills, but the skills of self confidence, non prejudicial social interaction, being able to take initiative, self reliance, respect & ownership of themselves & each other. Friendships and team work too, the standards that allow for continual, positive maturity in their lives, have developed. Seeing this firsthand and up close is an amazing experience for a sports coach & one that makes for total enjoyment, an inspiration in doing what I do with such an opportunity. Kids Tennis Foundation is a necessary component in tennis, as without it, so many young people would never have the opportunity to play this sport, never experience the joy & fun of tennis & perhaps never realise that they may be a future star of this greatest of games. The Foundation fully supports the schools with equipment, the coaches, the teaching supervisors. Without KTF, as a coach, the avenues to present tennis within an educational environment, especially non private government schools would be a scarce commodity. I, personally, will be continuing to work with KTF, the school, for as long as I can, to take students as far as I can within tennis. There might be that 'star' waiting to be awakened & developed! I can only see positives with KTF being able to continue to bring tennis to schools in Australia. For myself working in conjunction with KTF, I have not only been able to mentor these students as sports persons, I have experienced growth as both a tennis coach & as an individual in my own approach, attitudes to others of all ages. I cannot recommend highly enough the program that KTF offers schools in Australia and I cannot recommend highly enough that other coaches become involved with KTF programs & I cannot recommend highly enough that all primary schools come "on board" through the tennis in school grants that are available to them.
