Award Nomination Criteria





MOST OUTSTANDING 35+ TENNIS SENIOR

The mission of 35+ Seniors Tennis is to increase the playing opportunities and social interaction for tennis players of all standards over age 35. This award recognises involvement in 35+ Seniors Tennis as a player, administrator or both. The recipient of this award has been involved in raising the public profile of 35+ seniors tennis through demonstrated excellence in playing performance or administration, and demonstrated behaviours that exhibit a high level of integrity.

Eligibility Criteria

This award is open to male and female players and administrators who are:

- Current members of Tennis Seniors Australia; and
- Registered to Tennis Australia via My Tennis (desirable).

Nominees may self-nominate or be nominated by another person (note: if you self-nominate you will require a seconder to support your nomination).

All entries must provide the following media to support their submission:

• Three (3) high-resolution photos (in RAW format or TIFF/JPEG in highest file size possible)

Selection Criteria

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominations:

- Continued involvement in 35+ Seniors Tennis over a prolonged period of time whether it be as a player or administrator or both;
- Assisted in raising the public profile of 35+ Seniors Tennis through demonstrated excellence in playing performance or administration or both; and
- Demonstrated behaviours that exhibit a high level of integrity.

Selection Process

Only information provided by the nominee with their online nomination form will be considered by the selection panel. Nominees should attach any relevant additional information with their online nomination form.

All decisions in relation to the **Most Outstanding 35+ Tennis Senior** award (including any questions in relation to eligibility) will be determined by the selection panel in its absolute discretion. All decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Any matters which arise which are not covered in this document will be determined by the selection panel in consultation with Tennis West Management.

- Nominations are valid for the 2017/18 tennis season.
- The WA Tennis Industry Awards Night will be held on Friday, 12 October 2018
- Winners of their respective categories at the WA Tennis Industry Awards will be nominated for the Newcombe Medal Australian Tennis Awards
- Newcombe Medal Monday, 26 November 2018

Requirements of Award Recipients

The successful recipient will be required to fulfil the following:

- Participate in marketing and promotional activities in the 12 months following the award
- Prepare an article for the Australian Tennis Magazine. Tennis Australia will provide editorial assistance
- Participate in a best practice discussion during the 2019 Australian Grand Slam® Coaches' Conference if required.

Nomination Submission

Nominations should include:

- Executive Summary (approximately 200 words) briefly summarise the key points of the Nomination Report.

- Supporting Documents, if applicable (maximum of three pages) as relevant to the award, e.g. letter of endorsement, posters/flyers, program information.
- Supporting Photographs, if applicable (minimum of three high resolution photos).
