

EDITING TOURNAMENT FACT SHEETS ON YOUR TOURNAMENT WEBSITE

When your tournament has been successful in its online application for an Australian Rankings tournament, Tennis Australia will create your Tournament Planner (TP) file and publish it to create your tournament website on http://tournaments.tennis.com.au

A new feature that was added last year was the online tournament fact sheet which uses information that was completed in the online tournament application to list various details about the event.

Details that are listed on the fact sheet are the following:

- Tournament Tile
- Dates Specifically for main draw and qualifying events
- Club Address Details
- Contact Details Phone, Fax, Email and Website
- Number of Courts
- Court Surface
- Entry Fees
- Points Level
- Travel / Accommodation Information
- Information Meetings / Functions and Activity details
- Any other additional information

The more information you list on the fact sheet for your tournament, the easier it will be for participants and support teams to prepare for your tournament accordingly.

And because information listed on the fact sheet is public and people are becoming more aware to look at them when entering tournaments, it is vital that you review your fact sheet and update it accordingly prior to the online entries opening.

To update the fact sheet, follow these simple steps.

<u>STEP 1</u>

You should receive an automated email from Tournament Software. The email address they use is <u>noreply@tournamentsoftware.com</u>

You should have received it in your inbox, although it is possible it could have been delivered to your junk mail folder, so please ensure you check it.



Open the email. It will look like the one below.

Go to <u>http://tournaments.tennis.com.au</u> and click the "login" link on the right hand side of the website. After you have done this, you will see the screen below.
