Award Nomination Criteria





COACHING EXCELLENCE – CLUB

This award recognises the coaches that work within their local communities The coach provides quality coaching programs, is actively involved in growing the game and provides competition opportunities for players to progress their game.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible for consideration, the nominee must:

- Be a current Tennis Australia Qualified Coach Member (min. Junior Development)
- Be delivering quality coaching programs and providing pathways which cater to the needs of players within their community;
- Have a strong relationship with the club/facility committee/management;
- Be actively involved in his/her club/facility in growing the game of tennis;
- Actively seek positive relationships with local schools and the general community; and
- Provide opportunities for players to move from coaching programs to competitions and tournaments.

Nominees may self-nominate or be nominated by another person (note: if you self-nominate you will require a seconder to support your nomination).

All entries must provide the following media to support their submission:

• Three (3) high-resolution photos (in RAW format or TIFF/JPEG in highest file size possible)

Selection Criteria

The selection panel will consider the following in assessing nominations:

- Coaching program provided (including ANZ Tennis Hot Shots, Cardio Tennis, and Talent Development)
- 2 Roles and responsibilities at Club/Centre
- 3 Contribution to Club/Community
- 4 Total number of coaching participants from 1 July 2014 to 30 June 2015
- 5 Percentage of coaching participants playing competition/tournaments (e.g., intra or inter-club or tournaments)
- Number of Tennis in School sessions provided and participants logged in My Tennis from 1 July 2014 to 30 June 2015
- 7 System in place to transition players from schools to club program
- 8 Qualifications of coaching staff (Continued overleaf..)

- 9 Professional development opportunities accessed by coach and coaching staff in 2014 & 2015
- 10 Coaching business website
- 11 Customer service policies and procedures
- 12 Sample marketing material
- 13 Sample communication material to customers

Selection Process

Only information provided by the nominee with their nomination form will be considered by the selection panel. Nominees should attach any relevant additional information with their nomination form.

All decisions in relation to the Coaching Excellence –Club award (including any questions in relation to eligibility) will be determined by the selection panel in its absolute discretion. All decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
