



Matches are the best of 3(three) FAST4 sets

RULES

- Each Set is the first to 4 games (each match is the best of 3 sets)
- Tiebreak at 3 games all – first to 5 points
- No lets
- No Ad scoring

A short tiebreak is a tiebreak played as the first to five (5) points with the deciding point at 4-4.

- The player whose turn it is to serve at the commencement of the tiebreak (Player A) will serve two 2 points.
- The opposing player (Player B) will then serve two points.
- Players will only change ends after the first four points have been played.
- Player A will then serve two points.
- Player B will then serve the following two points and if the score reaches 4-4 then Player B will serve the final point of the tiebreak (Receiver choosing the service side).

All rubbers will be played using No Advantage Scoring with the Receiver choosing the service side when the game reaches Deuce.

No Service Lets will be played - meaning if the ball hits the net cord on a serve and lands/bounces within the correct service box then play will continue.

In doubles an “In Let” serve can be returned by either player on the receiver’s end.
