The Competitions Committee will assess the merit of the applications in accordance with the below Club nomination criteria:

### Player Nomination Criteria

- At least 4 of the nominated players must have a UTR higher than 8.9

### Club Nomination Criteria

- Affiliated club with strategic objective fit with talent development programmes
- Team strength, playing history, team tennis success
- Capacity to resource a strong junior state league team
- Club support
- Coaching level, player-performance pathways, leverage talented player development
- Venue suitability including seating, changerooms, spectator shade, 4 court-availability
- Personnel & volunteer resourcing, match supervisors screened

### Age Restrictions

The league includes all players who are 18 years and younger.

There is also a minimum age for players of 13 years of age. This age will be taken at the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Round 1 for the 2023-2024 season.

### 4 Courts per fixture (Recommended)

4 courts per fixture is advised for nominating a Boys State League team, however if this is not possible due to court allocation issues, the club MUST advise Tennis West of solutions and plan to finish matches in the time schedule.



### **Court Monitors**

It is mandatory that all Boys State League clubs provide an Officially trained 'Court Monitor'. Training is provided [here](#).

### **Encouragement of Clubs Collaborating to Create a Team**

The aim is to ensure competitive matches suited to the development of talented players. Therefore, as there are only a certain number of players of the appropriate standard, we are encouraging clubs to collaborate to form a team. E.g. Blue Gum Park/Midland

### **Team Uniforms**

Team uniforms are advised and encouraged to enhance the team experience. Uniform designs are to be sent to Tennis West for approval before the start of the season.

### **DISCLAIMER**

With completion and submission of this application, and subsequent success for a Junior State League team, your club agrees to the following terms and conditions. Failure to comply may result in Tennis West revoking your right to a team.

Your club agrees not to engage in any conduct or do anything that will bring, or is likely to bring, Tennis into ridicule or disrepute.

Your club agrees to appoint a team manager who holds a valid Working with Children Check and a National Police Check. (if required)

Your club agrees to remain an affiliated club and to pay the team nomination fee of **\$250.00** within the invoiced deadline. This fee will cover the associated costs of running the competition including officiating for semi-finals and, where possible, Chair Umpires for the final.

Tennis West will administer the league through an online software platform

Your club agrees to conduct fixtures as per the Tennis West League Rules, and in accordance with all applicable Tennis Australia and ITF policies, procedures, By-Laws, guidelines, rules and regulations (each as amended from time to time), which are available upon request, and which include but are not limited to Tennis Australia's Member Protection Policy, the Anti-Doping Policy, the Code of Behaviour, the Disciplinary Policy, Social Media Policy and the Uniform Tennis Anti-Corruption Program made available at [here](#).
