Tennis West Hot Shots Orange Ball League

COURT/BALL MODIFICATIONS:

Court size:

- Singles 18.29m long x 6.4m wide
- Measure 2.88 metres in from both traditional baselines
- Measure 0.86 metres in from both traditional sidelines (See Diagram to the right)

Doubles - 18.29m long x 8.22m wide

- Measure 2.88 metres in from both traditional baselines
- Use the traditional singles sidelines

Service box is the same for singles and doubles (shaded)

Net height: Lowered to 80cm.

Ball:

The Orange ball is to be used (Which is 50% compression of a full compression Yellow ball)

FAST4 RULES

- Each Set is the first to 4 games
- Play lets
 - If the ball hits the net cord on a serve and lands/bounces within the correct service box then play will continue.
 - In doubles a "let" serve can be returned by either player on the receiver's end.
- > No Ad scoring
 - All games will be played using No Advantage Scoring, with the Receiver choosing the service side when the game reaches Deuce.
- > Tiebreak at 3 games all first to 5 points See below how a FAST4 Tiebreak is played

A FAST4 tiebreak, is a tiebreak played first to five (5) points with the deciding point at 4-4.

- The player whose turn it is to serve at the commencement of the tiebreak (Player A) will serve two 2 points. (Serving to the deuce court first)
- The next player in the serving rotation (Player B) will then serve two points.
- Players will change ends after the first four points have been played. (Note: if the score gets to 4-4, players DO NOT change ends again)
- Player A (or C for doubles) will then serve two points.
- Player B (or D for doubles) will then serve the following two points and if the score reaches 4-4 then Player B (player D for doubles) will serve the final point of the tiebreak (Receiver choosing the service side).
