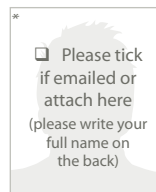

Official accreditation

Every participant who registers for the full conference package will receive ground pass accreditation to access Melbourne Park during the Australian Open from 14–16 January 2013. Delegates registering for single days will receive day pass access for time at the conference only. Passport photo (original or jpeg file), date of birth and signed accreditation agreement must be provided to obtain your pass.

Transport and Parking

Trains and trams are the easiest and most convenient way to access Melbourne Park. Richmond, Flinders Street and Jolimont

train stations are all within walking distance to Melbourne Park. All conference participants with Australian Open accreditation are able to enjoy a free tram service on the Melbourne tram network for the duration of their accreditation. Public car parking is available (subject to availability) at Yarra Park car park (MCG car park). Parking is \$10 per day and must be paid at time of registration and prior to 31 December 2012.

Accommodation
