3. SATURDAY- ONE RD MENS AND ONE RD WOMENS QUALIFYING
4. SUNDAY FINAL RD MENS AND WOMENS QUALIFYING
5. MENS AND WOMENS DOUBLES SIGN IN CLOSES 12NOON SUNDAY
6. DECISION ON WOMENS DOUBLES QUALIFYING PENDING

7. MAIN DRAW SINGLES AND DOUBLES TO START MONDAY
8. SINGLES MON/TUES FIRST ROUND SPLIT
